

# Annual Seminar

On Thursday, February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2008 the Men's Garden Club of Youngstown and the Ohio State University Extension of Mahoning County will host their 3<sup>rd</sup> annual winter seminar to be held at the Davis Center in Fellows Riverside Gardens, the jewel of the Mill Creek MetroPark.

The all-day seminar features four 75-minute educational sessions conducted by horticultural experts from across the state of Ohio. In the morning session **Dr. Bill Zumber**, retired professor – Walsh Univ. and owner of Adrian Flowers will discuss *Hostas and Other Shade Stuff*, followed by **Dr. Curtis Young**, Educator with the OSU Extension's Allen County branch telling you *Why You Should Like Insects*. After lunch you'll hear about the latest in *Wine Research* with Enologist **Dr. Todd Steiner** of the Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center in Wooster, and then wrap up the day with instruction on *Landscape Design* from Ass't Professor of Horticulture at Ohio State University, **Dr. Laura Deeter**.
